Day 1 Nairobi Airport – Amboseli National Park.

You will be picked up from the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi by our representative and will be on our way to the Amboseli National Park. This park is located by the most famous African symbol, Mount Kilimanjaro. Amboseli National Park is 392 square kilometers and is south to Nairobi. With a clear day, we may see as we advance in our safari, the amazing views of Mount Kilimanjaro, the highest mountain in Africa with 5896 m high. Its waters feed the seasonal swamps, which are also a source of food and water for the wild animals and birds living there. It is here where photographers use their abilities to capture the famous image of an elephant or a giraffe with the magnificent snowed mountain behind. We will reach the camp at lunchtime. Afternoon safari until it is time to go back to the camp to rest. Full-board in **AA Amboseli Lodge**.

Day 2 Amboseli National Park full day.

Full day in Amboseli doing game drive in the morning and in the afternoon, seeking the large elephant herds, buffaloes, lions, etc. We will go to the Kilimanjaro viewpoint to witness the wonderful views. Full-board in **AA Amboseli Lodge**.

Day 3 Amboseli National Park – Mto wa Mbu (Tanzania, cultural tourism, bike safari) – Karatu.

Early breakfast in the camp and we will be on our way to the Namanga border between Kenya and Tanzania, where we will begin the process of crossing the international border and request a visa. Once all requirements are met, we will change vehicles and guide and will begin our Tanzanian adventure. Our first stop is in **Mto wa Mbu**, near the **Rift Valley**. Here, we can visit an orphanage and a primary school if we wish. We can also stroll along the rice, potatoes and onion fields, as well as a local factory where beer is produced from banana. We can also enjoy a **bike safari** up to Lake Manyara and observe flamingos, pelicans, zebras, giraffes, warthogs and many more. For lunch, we will have a **wonderful barbeque** in a local restaurant and have, this way, a Tanzanian experience. We will leave the area in the afternoon and will drive towards Karatu where our hotel is located. Full-board in **Eileen's Tree Inn**.

Serengeti Mbugani Tented Camp



Day 4 Karatu – Serengeti National Park, Central Area.

Early after breakfast and with our picnic, we will drive towards the Serengeti National Park. We must cross the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, having the opportunity to engage ourselves in diverse activities or, if we prefer, continue to the Serengeti, the endless plain. Upon arrival, we will begin our game drive until late afternoon. Full-board in **Serengeti Acacia Tented Camp** or **Serengeti Mbugani Camp**.

Day 5 Serengeti National Park Central Area, full day.

We can use this day to explore deeply what the park can offer us, with the objective of finding the Great Five: buffalo, elephant, lion, rhino and leopard. Our afternoon can be a time for indulging ourselves with an unforgettable sunset in the Savannah. Picnic lunch with coffee/tea so that we can use time efficiently. Full-board in **Serengeti Acacia Tented Camp** or **Serengeti Mbugani Camp**.

Not-included activity for today: an amazing balloon safari.

Day 6 Serengeti National Park Central Area – Ngorongoro Conservation Area.

We will continue exploring the Serengeti park until midday, after which we will drive towards the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. We will spend the night there and enjoy our fantastic hotel. Full-board in **Lake Masek Tented Camp** or **Lake Ndutu Luxury Tented Camp**.

Day 7 Ngorongoro Crater – Tarangire National Park.

Very early and with the first rays of the sun, we will drive down one of the wonders of the world, the Ngorongoro Crater. There, we will start the search for the endangered Black Rhino that lives among 25.000 other mammals. Picnic lunch in the crater, resuming our safari soon after and driving towards the Munge River, where we will seek lions with the darkest mane. We will leave the crater behind and drive to the Tarangire National Park to spend the night. Full-board in **Sangaiwe Tented Lodge** or **Lake Burunge Tented Camp**.

Day 8 Tarangire National Park – Arusha.

We will have breakfast in the hotel and we will be soon in the park seeking the large and famous colony of elephants and also the characteristic baobabs that decorate this spectacular park. We will continue our safari to fully explore every corner, looking for lions, leopards, giraffes, impala, buffalo and many more. In the afternoon, we will head to Arusha where a hot shower and a well-served meal awaits. Bed and breakfast in **Karama Lodge** or **Planet Lodge**.

Day 9 Arusha City – Maasai Market – Lunch – Return.

After breakfast and with our tour guide, we will go out for a stroll in the busy and colorful city of Arusha. This will be a great chance to get to know this city first-hand and mingle with locals. We can also visit the famous “Maasai Market” where we may do some shopping and take a souvenir back home. At midday, we will have a delicious barbeque in a local restaurant if time allows.
