#### Day 1 Kilimanjaro Airport - Arusha.

You will be received by our representative at the Kilimanjaro Airport and transferred to the hotel, after which you will be informed of the itinerary. Bed and breakfast in **Karama Lodge** or **Planet Lodge**.

### Day 4 Serengeti National Park Northern Area – Crossing the Mara River, The Great Migration.

We will begin our adventure at the Mara River right after breakfast. If lucky, we may witness a show hard to forget: the crossing of the Mara River by the wildebeest. We will go on a game drive around this area, observing an endless number of wild animals and great herds of wildebeest along zebras, lions and antelopes. We will see in the river the Nile crocodiles' movements, which may weigh as much as 1000 kg. We will return to the hotel in the afternoon for a hot shower and a well deserved dinner. Full-board in Serengeti View Camp or Mbugani Migration Camp.

#### Day 2 Arusha – Lake Manyara National Park – Karatu.

Breakfast early in the morning to be on our way towards the Lake Manyara National Park, where we will be able to enjoy our afternoon seeking the famous climbing lions living there. This is also a great place to see large troops of baboons, elephants, zebras and many more animals. This is with no doubt, the park to observe birds such as pelicans, or the majestic flamingos, that attracted by the lake's waters, show of their plumage while fishing, producing a pink optic effect that can be seen from far. Picnic lunch in the park. In the afternoon, we will drive towards the town of Karatu on the Rift Valley to spend the night. Full-board in Eileen's Tree Inn or Country Lodge.

# Day 3 Karatu – Serengeti National Park Northern Area.

We will be on our way early in the morning and after breakfast. With our picnic lunch, we will drive towards the Serengeti National Park, crossing the Ngorongoro Conservation Area on the way. Once there, we will begin out game drive as we move towards the north in order to follow the fantastic Great Migration. Late afternoon, we will drive to our camp in the middle of the savannah where we will spend the night. Full-board in Serengeti View Camp or Mbugani Migration Camp.

# Day 5 Serengeti National Park Northern to Central Area - Ndutu Plains.

Soon after breakfast, we will be on our way towards the central area in Serengeti, as we look for the Seronera Valley. Safari in this beautiful area. We will leave the park behind in the afternoon and will drive towards the famous Ndutu Plains, where the Great Migration begins from December to April. This place is worth it visiting even out of this period because we can see felines easier here than somewhere else. We will spend the night in a charming tented camp located across Lake Masek and near the Ndutu Lake. These will be the best views around, which may include animals coming to drink water. Full-board in Lake Masek Tented Camp or Lake Ndutu Luxury Tented Camp.



#### Day 6 Ndutu Plains - Ngorongoro Crater - Arusha.

Breakfast early in the morning and we will be on our way to the wonder of the world: the Ngorongoro Crater, where we will begin the search for the endangered Black Rhino, living among 25.000 other mammals. We will continue our safari until Munge River, where we can see lions with the darkest mane. Picnic lunch in the crater and we will continue our safari on route leaving the crater and towards the city of Arusha. We will be dropped off at the hotel for the night. Bed and breakfast in **Karama Lodge** or **Planet Lodge**.





#### Day 7 Arusha City – Maasai Market – Lunch – Return.

After breakfast and with our tour guide, we will go out for a stroll in the busy and colorful city of Arusha. This will be a great chance to get to know this city first-hand and mingle with locals. We can also visit the famous "Maasai Market" where we may do some shopping and take a souvenir back home. At midday, we will have a delicious barbeque in a local restaurant if time allows. When the time is right, we will be transferred to the Kilimanjaro Airport to take our flight back home.

End of our services.
